IMPLEMENTATION OF CAAM AVIATION SECURITY (AVSEC) INCIDENT REPORT ON CARES

As part of the Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia's (CAAM) ongoing commitment to enhancing efficiency and streamlining safety reporting processes within Malaysia's aviation industry, CAAM is pleased to introduce a new incident reporting platform specifically designed for aviation security incidents. This platform, known as the Aviation Security (AVSEC) Incident Report, serves as an extension of the existing CAAM Aviation Reporting System (CAREs), outlined in Advisory Information 04/2023.

Since 12th July 2024, this platform has been fully operational and accessible to the public and all aviation stakeholders. It provides a streamlined and secure method for reporting any aviation security-related incidents.

The reporting platform can be accessed via CAAM official website, under the CAAM Aviation Reporting System (CAREs) at the following link [AVSEC Incident Report](#).

Any occurrences reported through the platform will be directly submitted to CAAM Aviation Security Division for further action. Reports can be filed either by individuals or on behalf of others, with an option for anonymity to ensure confidentiality.

CAAM encourages all aviation stakeholders to familiarise themselves with the CAREs platform and to report any incidents promptly and accurately.
